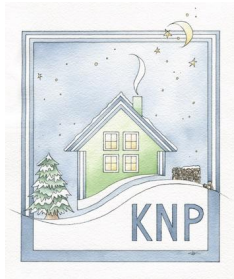

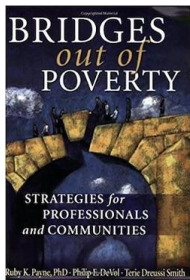
## From Our Editor, Nancy Allenby
