

Basil *Ocimum basilicum*

Genovese Basil

Intensely scented strain of Sweet Large Leaf basil. Sweet, fragrant leaves are excellent for cooking, drying, and fresh eating. Keep compact by pinching frequently.



Bush Bean - Green *Phaseolus vulgaris*

Savannah

Dark green, straight and smooth. Heavy yields. A favorite in the fields at Spring Ledge Farm. Delicious and crisp.



Chives *Allium schoenoprasum*

Garden Chives

Valued garden herb, wonderful for edging. Produces beautiful purple blooms. Re-seeds.



Cucumber *Cucumis sativus*

Marketmore

Popular non-hybrid. The market standard for slicing cucumbers. Grown by most fresh market growers in NH.



Dill *Anethum graveolens*

Fernleaf

Use the leaves for salads, soups, pickles. Dill flowers attract a multitude of beneficial insects.



Kale *Brassica napus pabularia*

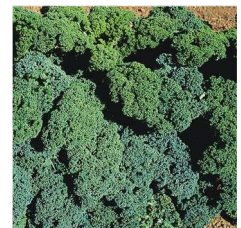
Red Russian

Tender, colorful. Stems are purple, leaves deep grey-green, purple-veined, flat, non-curved and tooth-edged. The plants mature medium-tall and the leaves are very tender compared to other kale varieties. For mixed salads and light cooking.



Winterbor Kale

Well-curved, blue-green leaves. Fancy quality, extra-productive kale. Tall, growing 2-3' with great yield and cold hardiness. Regrows vigorously for successive harvests.



Leek *Allium ampeloprasum*

Lincoln

Sweet flavor and ready in late August. Will withstand slight frosts.



Lettuce *Lactuca sativa*

Green Leaf

We use 'Waldmann's Dark Green' from Johnny's Selected Seeds of Albion, Me. Best for late spring and fall harvest.

Red Salad Bowl

A wine red version of Saladbowl - Oakleaf lettuce. Deeply lobed, delicate oak-like leaves form a full rosette. Slow to bolt and holds its mild, non-bitter salad quality for a long time. SLF has used this variety in the field with good success.



Marigold *Tagetes x (triploid)*

Gem Mix

A mixture of the edible Marigolds - lemon gem, orange gem, and red gem. Each lacy mound is covered with petite half inch single flowers with a citrusy scent. Great for containers or in the garden, also called signet marigolds, they are drought and deer resistant.



Onion *Allium cepa*

Mix Red & Yellow onions

A mix of red onions and yellow onions.



Parsley *Petroselinum crispum*

Italian(plain)

The very best broad celery-leaf type with flat, glossy, dark green leaves. Its erect, vigorous growth and strong flavor make it the favorite for flavoring.



Paste Tomato *Lycopersicon esculentum*

Mariana

Excellent internal and external color. Small to medium-sized plants have good fruit set and are high yielding. 4-6 oz. fruits are extremely uniform in shape, firm with thick walls, and have very good flavor. Good disease resistance. Determinate.



Pepper - Hot *Capsicum frutescens*

Jalapeno

Indispensable to Mexican cooking. often roasted or chopped. Dark green changing to red. Widely adapted.



Pepper - Sweet *Capsicum annuum*

Lunchbox Mix

These beautiful, mini-sized peppers are remarkably sweet and flavorful. They are delicious sautéed, as an addition to salads and, of course, perfect for a healthy snack. All three varieties have tall, strong plants that yield well for snack-type peppers.



Squash - summer *Cucurbita pepo*

Multipik

The standard for Spring Ledge grown yellow summer squash. Tender flesh, strong growth. Great for the home garden.



Squash - winter *Cucurbita*

Butternut

This fine Butternut type is the most popular winter squash. Fruit are 8-10 in. long with thick, cylindrical necks. Its flesh color is richer than others, and the fruit store well, late into winter.



Delicata

Unique 7-9" long and 3-4" wide 2 lb. fruit. Cream colored with dark green stripes. Very sweet orange flesh.



Swiss Chard *Beta vulgaris*

Bright Lights

AAS Winner. Multicolor chard. Stems of many colors including gold, pink, orange, purple, red and white. Lightly savoyed leaves with a mild taste.



Tomato - Cherry *Lycopersicon esculentum*

Sweet Million

Dark red fruit, disease resistant and a standard cherry for Spring Ledge field production. An improvement over 'Sweet 100' in quantity and quality of fruits.



Tomato - Heirloom *Lycopersicon esculentum*

Mortgage Lifter

Heirloom variety whose folklore claims to have lifted the breeder out of depression-era debt. Very large slicing tomato with great taste.



Tomato - Standard *Lycopersicon esculentum*

Early Girl

Long the standard of comparison for early slicing tomatoes. Heavy yields of slightly flattened bright crimson globes averaging 4-6 oz. Sweet, meaty flavor with a hint of tartness.
